## What is it exactly?

**14-week transformative experience** with employment & skills training.

35–40 hours per week for ~12 weeks.

## Paid Employment Placements

You will have access to full-time (35-40 hours/week) job opportunities from our partners across various industries.

## Professional Development Workshops

For the first two weeks you will participate in professional development workshops to help boost your employability.

## Ongoing Support

Katimavik Youth Employability Coordinators provide guidance, and career support during the program.

## Job Search Skills

You will learn effective job search strategies with the support of our Youth Employability Coordinators.

# Program Options

## Shared Housing

Live with other participants in a Katimavik community. Shared rooms (up to two per room). Housing, utilities, and internet fully covered. Travel costs to and from the host community are included.

## Local or Remote

Participants arrange and cover their own housing, utilities, and internet, whether staying in their home community or relocating.

# Expenses

Day-to-day expenses, such as transportation, meals, etc **will be the participant's responsibility**, as you'll be working full-time in a fully paid position during these 12 weeks.
